1 Characteristics and history

Osaka Kyoiku University (OKU) is one of the leading educational universities in Japan, which has 150 years of history and tradition. OKU offers an Evening Program for Elementary School Teacher Training, which is the only national program of its kind in Japan for working students and in-service teachers. OKU has two campuses in Kashiwara and Tennoji, and 10 affiliated schools and a kindergarten in three districts in Osaka prefecture. OKU provides two Master's programs; Graduate School of Education and The United Graduate School of Professional Teacher Education, and a Doctoral program, Graduate School of School Education (Ph.D.).

The main campus (Kashiwara Campus) is located about 20 km east of the center of Osaka, inside the Kongo-Ikoma-Kisen Quasi-National Park in Kashiwara City. The city has a long history with beautiful surroundings commanding verdant mountains.

Outline and characteristics of the course for Teacher Training Students

1 Characteristics of the program

• Students will visit OKU affiliated schools to observe classes and exchange opinions with teachers.

• Each student will be given detailed guidance based on his/her needs.

· Japanese tutors will support students with their studies and daily life.

2 Number of students to be accepted: 12 students

③ Period of scholarship: October, 2025 - March, 2027

④ Requirement for program completion

· Students will be required to write and present a final report.

•It is required to receive approximately 60 hours of thesis guidance. (The total number of hours may vary depending on the academic advisor).

•Participation in approximately 50 hours of school visits, interactions with local primary and secondary schools, and collaborative events with OKU students is desirable.

- · Certificate will be issued at the end of the program.
- (5) Outline of the course
- Japanese language education

Students will take intensive Japanese language lessons for 6 months at a language institute designated by MEXT. In case students have enough Japanese proficiency, they will study at OKU for one and half years. OKU offers Japanese classes from pre-intermediate, intermediate and pre-advanced level (4 sessions of 6 hours per week at each level) to advanced level (2 sessions of 3 hours per week).

• Specialized training (1 year or 1 and half years)

Each student will conduct research while receiving individual guidance from his/her academic advisor. Students will also be able to attend classes for undergraduate and graduate students.

•Practical training, participatory subjects such as field trips and regional exchanges


